Tips for a Successful Watch Party Event

Successful Watch Party Tips

Before jumping into planning the fine details of your event, it is important to first reflect on our collective desired outcome:

Things to Consider:	Suggestions:

Communication with Focus on the Family	Leading up to your event, you and/or your team are welcome to reach out to us at any time. We're here to support you! Email us at TruthRising@fotf.org
The Attendee Experience	Check-in: If desired, provide attendees with name tags Décor/Staging/Signage: Use logos/templates provided in the toolkit folder to create signage for your event. Signs can be placed on stage/windows/etc. Consider how can lighting be used to enhance the event space? Emcee and Host: About 10 minutes before the start of the show, this would be a great time to welcome guests, introduce your church, and let them know of any pertinent information like bathroom locations before getting started. After the program concludes, the Host can thank attendees and give instructions for post-event items if necessary. Food and Beverage: Depending on the time of your event, consider providing food and drinks before/after the program.
Post-Event Experience	Consider praying about the event. Have background music playing as guests walk out. Consider having a table with additional information on the study and how people can get involved after the event.
Execution Team	Think through who is leading the event: Logistics, greeters, A/V support, Volunteers

Event Execution Tips

You know your church, and you know what works best! With every event, we recommend having a step-by-step plan that covers important areas:

Things to Consider:	Suggestions:
Physical Set Up and A/V	We recommend having your production plan ready for your volunteer team prior to the event
Registration and Check-In at the Event	We recommend if you are choosing to do a registration for this event to schedule reminders to be sent out to attendees before the event. We recommend reaching out 2 weeks before and 1 day before the event.
Introduction Before Watching	We recommend you open with a general messaging about what they will see, followed by a quick prayer. Potential opening message: As you begin watching Truth Rising, you'll first hear from Os Guinness as he talks about the history of Western civilization—how we got here, and why this moment matters. Os helps lay the groundwork so that when you meet individuals choosing courage and conviction in the face of adversity, you'll be able to associate this cultural moment with the greater historical context.
Post Event Follow- Up	We would love for you to thank everyone for coming to your watch event and send them the free <i>Truth Rising: The Study</i> materials. (https://www.truthrising.com/the-study)

Event Execution Tips

To host the watch party, you will need:

- A good solid WIRED internet connection over ethernet from your internet router or firewall.
- An up-to-date computer. This can be a Windows PC, or an Apple Macintosh.
- A display device. This can be a large screen TV, a video projector and screen, or a high-resolution video wall.
- A sound system to present the audio from the streaming platform. This can be an independent sound system associated with the TV, or an audio connection from your computer to the mixer that feeds the auditorium sound system.

Check Your Internet Connection

In most cases, if your computer is connected to your internet router or firewall with an ethernet cable, that connection should be good, stable, and reliable.

- We would recommend 100Mbps, internet or faster.
- We do not recommend using wireless for streaming this documentary, because many times, the wireless service point is serving too many devices, and its bandwidth is divided among them. This can lead to slowdowns, buffering, and interruptions in your viewing experience.
- You will need at least 10 to 15 Mbps (Megabits-per-second) of dedicated network bandwidth for your computer to play the documentary successfully without interruptions.

Test Your Internet Speed

There are many internet speed test sites available. Use the one recommended by your internet service provider (ISP). If they don't have one, you can find one by searching Google, or use one of these listed below:

If your computer is a recently manufactured one, (0 to 4 years old) then it is probably up to the task. It should be running a current operating system, like Windows 10 or 11, or MacOS 10.15, through 14.x. Please make sure that your operating system is up to date, with all the current security patches, and drivers. Your anti-virus software should be updated as well.

Watching the Documentary

Display:

A display device can be a large screen TV, a video projector and screen, or a high-resolution video wall, if you can connect it to the computer that will be receiving the simulcast. It all depends on how many people will attend your hosting site. If it's a small number of people, like less than 50 in a small room, then a large screen TV will do. A larger number of people, in a larger room, will need a video projector and screen, or a high-resolution video wall, for all the attendees to be able to see adequately.

Sound:

This can be a sound system associated with or part of the TV, or an audio connection from your computer to the mixer that feeds the auditorium sound system. Just make sure it's a clean signal, and free from any hum or buzz.

Browser:

Chrome and Firefox are preferred, but Safari, Opera, and Microsoft Edge will work too. Use the one that gives you the best results with your system.

Driving Deeper Engagement

Have a discussion with the audience after watching the documentary. Below are some starter questions you may like to use to get conversations going:

Reflection & Personal Impact

- What part of the film impacted you the most, and why?
- How does this film help make sense of the world around you?
- Did anything in the documentary challenge your current beliefs or assumptions?
- How does the message of this film align or conflict with your understanding of Biblical Truth?
- How can we, as a faith community, respond to the issues raised in the film in a Christlike way?

Action-Oriented Questions

- What is one thing you feel called to do differently after watching this film?
- Are there areas in our community where we need to rise for truth and justice?
- How can we support each other in being bold truth-tellers in love?
- How can we pray for you to take action (no matter how small) in a particular area or situation?

Discussion Starters for Small Groups

- If you could ask the filmmakers one question, what would it be?
- What voices or perspectives were missing from the film that you wish had been included?
- How do we discern between truth and misinformation in today's world?





OS GUINNESS

HOST OF TRUTH RISING

Great-great grandson of the Dublin brewer Arthur Guinness, Os was born in China in World War II, where he witnessed the climax of the Chinese revolution in 1949.

His career has taken him from freelance reporting for the BBC, to serving as the executive director of the Williamsburg Charter Foundation, a bicentennial celebration of the First Amendment. From 1991 to 2004 he was a senior fellow at the Trinity Forum, and he has since been a frequent speaker and seminar leader at political and business conferences in both the United States and Europe.



JOHN STONESTREET HOST OF TRUTH RISING

Colson Center president John Stonestreet is a sought-after speaker and author on areas of faith and culture, theology, worldview, education and apologetics.

John is the daily voice of Breakpoint, the nationally syndicated commentary on the culture founded by the late Chuck Colson. He has co-authored five books and also serves as the instructor for the small-group curriculum to be released after the film.



SETH DILLON

Seth Dillon is the CEO of *The Babylon Bee*, a news satire site that is now more popular than *The Onion*. The Bee punches hard against wokeism and cancel culture. Dillon's stand against censorship and "deplatforming" has placed him on the front lines of the battle for free speech in the public square.




CHLOE COLE

Katy Faust is founder and president of Them Before Us, a global movement defending children's right to their mother and father. She publishes, speaks and testifies widely on why marriage and family are matters of justice for children.



JACK PHILLIPS

Jack Phillips, owner of Masterpiece Cakeshop, declined to bake a cake for a same-sex wedding in 2012 – a stance that took him to the Supreme Court. The legal attacks continue, but Jack continues to stand up for religious liberty.



BARONESS PHILIPPA STROUD

Baroness Philippa Stroud is CEO of the Legatum Institute. Previously, she was Chief Executive of the Centre for Social Justice (CSJ), a think tank that she co-founded in 2004. She has committed her life and career to tackling poverty and social breakdown.



NIALL FERGUSON

Sir Niall Ferguson is the Milbank Family Senior Fellow at the Hoover Institution, Stanford University, and a senior faculty fellow of the Belfer Center for Science and International Affairs at Harvard. He is an award-winning author of sixteen books and presenter of several award-winning television programs.




AYAAN HIRSI ALI


JOHN ANDERSON

John Anderson was the Deputy Prime Minister of Australia and Leader of the National Party from 1999 to 2005. During his time in office, he helped tackle budget repair and promoted economic growth. Known as a man of simple Christian faith, he sought to respect everyone's right to speak, even if he disagreed with them.

Konstantin Kisin is a *Sunday Times* best-selling author and political commentator, and one of the world's most popular podcasters. Since 2018, Kisin has been a co-host of one of Apple's top ranked political podcasts, *Triggernometry*.
