5 STEPS FOR VOTER REGISTRATION AT CHURCH

REGISTRATION DEADLINE
OCTOBER 20th

CHRISTIANS CAN HAVE A POSITIVE IMPACT ON ELECTIONS AND ULTIMATELY OUR NATION'S FUTURE. WE CAN HELP OUR PEOPLE OBEY CHRIST'S CALL TO PARTICIPATE IN GOVERNMENT (MATT. 22:21) BY ENCOURAGING VOTER REGISTRATION AND VOTING CHRISTIAN VALUES.

HERE ARE 5 EASY STEPS:

ASK

Get permission from your pastor and church leadership so that you're under biblical authority. When asking, emphasize that voter registration is:

Biblical: Selecting Godly leaders is rooted in biblical principle (Exod 18:21; Prof 29:2)

Simple: Federal laws have made voter reg easier than ever

Legal: The IRS says church voter-reg drives do not violate any regulations and are encouraged

PREPARE

Obtain Voter reg forms from County office. Voters can mail or they can be collected and submitted in person. For state voter registration policies and contact info, <https://www.usa.gov/election-office>. Train your volunteers on the rules for voter reg and ensure they're kept non-partisan. Schedule drives with anticipation and prepare your congregation through advertisement and encouragement

REGISTER

On a Sunday where your pastor preaches on Biblical Citizenship, have a table setup in the lobby in a high-traffic area, recruit a team of trained volunteers, and have all the resources available. Be friendly, provide assistance, keep records. Send folks already registered to get non-partisan voter info at www.pafamilyvoter.org

STAY LEGAL

- Always stay non-partisan
- Always list the name of the organization hosting the voter registration drive
- Refrain from materials that criticize or praise any political candidate for more guidance on the legal process, please contact our Independence Law Center at www.independencelaw.org

FOLLOW UP

Have a plan to translate voter registration into values voting and getting out the vote. Ask the pastor to encourage the congregation to vote their Biblical Values. Provide a signup sheet for people who need a ride to the polls and/or childcare. Encourage absentee voters to vote by mail or vote early.
