# 2024 ABORTION STATISTICS

## Executive Summary

Pennsylvania has monitored and reported on abortion data since 1975. This report is produced pursuant to Section 3214 of the Abortion Control Act, 18 Pa. C.S. § 3214(e)(1).

In 2024, there were 32,946 abortions performed in Pennsylvania. Nearly half of all abortions performed in Pennsylvania were to both white (13,859) and to Black or African-American individuals (14,956) while abortions to individuals of Hispanic origin accounted 13.6 percent (4,487). More than 88 percent (28,999) of the abortions performed in Pennsylvania in 2024 were to unmarried individuals.

Nearly all abortions in 2024 (30,599 or 92.9%) were performed in the first 14 weeks of pregnancy.

The age group having the most abortions was 25-29, accounting for 9,144 (27.8 percent) of all 2024 abortions. Individuals under age 20 accounted for 8 percent of all abortions in 2024, and individuals under age 18 accounted for 2.4 percent. Comparatively, in 2023, individuals under age 20 accounted for 8.1 percent, and individuals under age 18 accounted for 2.5 percent.

92.6 percent of the abortions performed in 2024 were to Pennsylvania residents. Residents of other states, territories and other countries accounted for 2,451 abortions in 2024, a decrease from 2,926 in 2023.

Of the abortions performed in 2024 in Pennsylvania, about 93 percent were performed in ten counties: Allegheny; Berks; Bucks; Dauphin; Delaware; Lehigh; Montgomery; Northampton; Philadelphia; and York.

More than 34 percent of Pennsylvania residents having abortions were residents of Philadelphia County. Other counties with high number of resident abortions included: Allegheny (3,608); Montgomery (1,880); Delaware (2,185); Lehigh (1,066); Bucks (842); and Dauphin (824).

In 2024, there were 480 reports of complications from abortions that were submitted by physicians; 9.1 percent less than the 524 reported in 2023. More than 78 percent of the complications were related to retained products of conception, 16.3 percent to bleeding and 2.3 percent to infection.

Notes: The source for the number of abortions reported in Pennsylvania in 2024 is the "Report of Induced Termination of Pregnancy," which is an individual report filed for each procedure. The source for the complications data is "Abortions: Report of Complications," a separate reporting form completed by physicians who have provided medical care to an individual because of a complication resulting from an abortion or attempted abortion.

Unknowns are excluded from all calculations.
