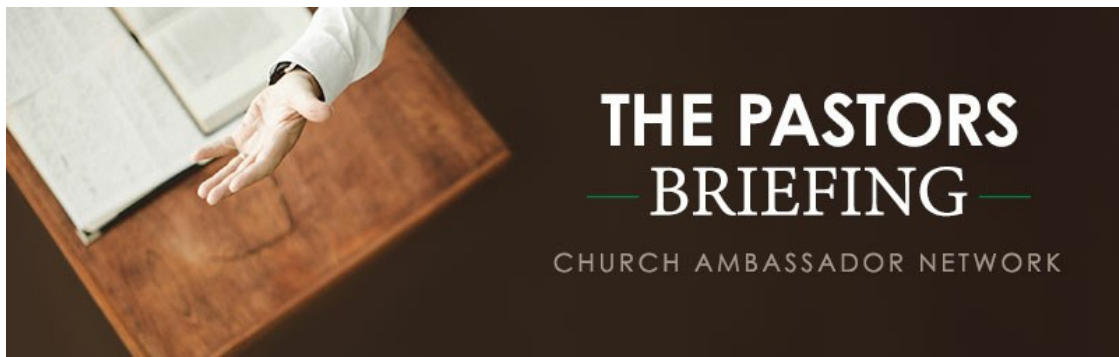




Will you stand up for life with us?

On **Monday, September 21**, thousands of Pennsylvanians will gather in Harrisburg for the **6th Annual [Pennsylvania March for Life](#)** to peacefully and publicly affirm the God-given dignity of every human life. As our nation celebrates 250 years of liberty, there is no better time for the Church to stand together in defense of the first and most fundamental right—the **right to life**.

It all happens on the steps of the PA Capitol in Harrisburg. Worship and prayer start at 10 am, the Rally begins at 11 am, and the March around the Capitol begins after the Rally.
